The PW Mark is an accreditation scheme that recognises eligible firms that pay progressive wages to lower-wage workers.

Why get PW Mark

Your firm can benefit from greater visibility and support from your consumers.

Your firm will also fulfil the new government procurement terms. Firms that are eligible for the PW Mark and are awarded Government contracts for new tenders called from 1 March 2023 and new quotations from 1 March 2024, are required to be accredited with the PW Mark for the contract period. Their subcontractors that are eligible for the PW Mark are also required to be accredited.

Firms may select "Apply" to proceed to the application page. The application is expected to take around 5 minutes to complete. You should receive the outcome of your firm's PW Mark application within 5 business days. As the PW Mark Plus application includes the adoption of the requisite **TS-LWW** (if not an existing adopter), the application may take up to 1.5 months to be processed, and your firm may receive the PW Mark first if it meets the eligibility criteria.
