

IMIS password complexity

Following is the recommended complexity for security purpose

- Blank-field passwords are NOT allowed.
- Should NOT contain the user's account name or parts of the user's full name that exceed two consecutive characters
- Passwords should contain at least 12 characters or as the appropriate characters as the system supports.
- Passwords should contain characters from three (3) of the following four (4) categories:
 - English uppercase characters (A through Z)
 - English lowercase characters (a through z)
 - Base 10 digits (0 through 9)
 - Non-alphabetic characters (for example, !, \$, #, %, &, * etc)
- Passwords should be actively cycled once every 90 days.

Example: Asdfghjklf3#
